- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com Benin: Pastor Michel leads a small church in northern Benin. In September 2021, around 60 Voodooists who live in his village arrived at the church during a service. They broke down the church door and smashed its windows, ordering the Christians to stop worshiping and praying. They attacked Pastor Michel, breaking his leg. They said if he did not stop holding church services, they would kill him. The Pastor's leg has never fully healed, and so he requires a crutch for mobility. Because he can no longer work as a farmer, he has been provided with a small mill he uses to grind crops to support his family.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-Northern Uzbek in China: Their history in China dates back to the time of the Mongol hordes who dominated Central Asia and China in the thirteenth century. They descended from traders who traveled along the Silk Road. The name Uzbek probably came from a Mongol ruler of the Golden Horde who spread Islam throughout many parts of the empire. They are not open to outside spiritual input. There are a few Uzbek Christians in China today. Pray for Uzbek believers to allow the Holy Spirit to permeate all aspects of their lives. Pray they would be obedient when the Lord tells them to go.
- * 2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #13 Saudi Arabia: Prayer Points: Pray that secret believers who are isolated will find ways to connect with other believers online. Thank God for the courage of believers who are sharing their faith. Pray that God will continue to build His church through their witness.
