Jay & Allison Tolleson, Sebeka, MN (Heartland District: Randy & Lisa Picklesimer): Sebeka is in north-central Minnesota, about an hour west of Brainerd, MN, and about 1.5 hours east of Fargo, ND. Blowers Chapel is located about 10 miles outside Sebeka and 12 miles from 3 other communities.

We are surrounded by low-lying swampy areas mixed with some agriculture and northern woods. There are many lakes within a short distance of us.

PRAYER REQUESTS: 1) Pray that God would continue to help us grow together as a church body and help us grow in our knowledge of Him. 2) Pray for wisdom in reaching out to the multiple communities around us with the Gospel. 3) Pray for our current outreach events, especially so that we can establish new connections in nearby communities. 4) Pray for our summer activities, including County Fairs, parades, and a VBS. 5) Pray for personal friendships for our family (us and our three children); we moved here in 2021. - * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com- Mexico: Mateo and Elena are church planters in Central Mexico. Their town is in a region known as the "Circle of Silence," where Christians are routinely opposed by those who follow a syncretistic blend of Catholicism, animism and the occult. The couple has experienced hostility from their community because of their witness for Christ. Their tires have been slashed, their bank accounts have been hacked, and they recently received a threatening note to stop their evangelistic activities: "First warning. You must leave. You may not preach, you or your wife." Men on motorcycles also threatened them with guns at their front door. The couple has two young daughters, ages 5 and 3, and their older daughter has been bullied at school because of her Christian faith.

 Sharib in Chad: They live in eastern Chad, in an area with plentiful water supply so
 they can cultivate gardens around the rivers and the people don't have to move their
 herds around. At the beginning of the rainy season, they make sacrifices before
 planting millet, the main crop...they ask for the blessing of enough rain and a good
 harvest. They need to understand that Isa (Jesus) is much more than a human prophet.
 Mission agencies could show Jesus' love and power by sending teams of medical
 workers to provide for medical needs. They also need schools for their children, and
 Christian teachers could help meet that need. Few Abu Sharib are followers of Christ.

 Pray the tiny church will flourish. Ask the Lord to send workers who can tell them
 the good news of Jesus Christ. Pray for hearts that are open to the gospel.
