- \* Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com India: In the Bastar district of Chhattisgarh State, Christians face increasing pressure and violence for following Christ. A mom and her 2 teenage children are the only believers in their village since coming to faith in Christ two years ago. Village neighbors repeatedly tried to force them to reconvert to Hinduism, but they remained strong in the Lord, so the village excommunicated them. They are cut off from the village water supply and cannot graze their cattle on common fields. Threats were even made against her son's life. His sister went to the police to seek protection and get her brother out of the village to safety. She and her mother remain in the village. She said, "As long as I live, I will follow Jesus." Pray for this family's protection, encouragement and faith.
- \* Unreached People <a href="https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today">https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today</a>- Ho in Bangladesh: They are known for their independent nature, which has historically separated them from the rule of powerful Hindus. They are most comfortable in the forest environment that supplies many of their necessities. Their major agricultural crop is rice, which they ferment to make beer. The New Testament is printed in the Ho language and some mission agencies work among them. Mission efforts have led to a small community of Christ followers, but there is a need for more outreach. Pray that the church would thrive and that they would spread the word to their neighbors. Pray for the Ho people to be able to make their own spiritual decisions, free from outside pressures. Pray for their physical needs to be met by the Lord, leading them to put their faith in him alone.
- \* 2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #20-Mauritania: Prayer Points: Pray that the families of new believers would have open hearts and minds, instead of rejecting the believer.
