Pray for:

- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com. Somalia: Hawa is a Christian convert from Islam who maintains a farm in a rural area of Somalia. Though raised as a Muslim, Hawa became a follower of Christ through her son's witness. Her Muslim husband divorced her and kicked her out of the house when he learned of her newfound faith. Through another Christian woman, Hawa came to work on the farm, which houses 19 Christian widows whose husbands had been killed by a terrorist group active in Somalia and Kenya. Hawa disciples the widows and actively shares her faith with other women who work on neighboring farms. In March 2024, fighting broke out between the terrorists and the Somali government, destroying some of the crops, displacing Hawa and the widows, and killing one of the women. Pray for them during this time of transition.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-Akhvakh in Russia: The Akhvakh are almost entirely folk Muslims who seek out shamans and use the Koran like a talisman. They are a ranching people who raise livestock and chickens and live in nine villages in central Dagestan and in ethnic neighborhoods in urban areas. Many have assimilated into the Avars, but they still keep cultural distinctives. Mixed marriages are increasingly common. Most, if not all, are bilingual, speaking Akhvakh at home and Avar in public. Elementary grade education is in Avar, secondary is in Russian, but neither is their mother tongue. Missionary obstacles include terrain, syncretism, lack of Scripture in their heart language and Russian law against proselytism. Pray that the urban Akhvakh would open up to the gospel and begin a Disciple Making Movement with their rural kinsfolk. Pray for the two or three believers in one family, for their protection and growth in faith and witness.
- * 2024 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians): #40 Qatar: Praise God that expatriate Christians in Qatar can worship in relative freedom. Pray for strength for secret believers under pressure from their families and communities. Pray that they will be able to meet with other Christians. Pray that God will open the hearts of the authorities so that Qataris might be able to follow Jesus openly.
