- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com- Bhutan: A Christian youth conference scheduled in Bhutan was disrupted when authorities raided the location and demanded that organizers show permits, which did not exist because Christian events are not allowed by the Buddhist government. Authorities then summoned the organizers for interrogation. The raid caused organizers of other youth events to change their plans as they wait to see the consequences. Pray for Christians in Bhutan who are reaching and discipling young people to have wisdom and courage as they plan and lead their ministries so that many will come to know and follow Jesus Christ in Bhutan.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today- Hunan Iu Mien in China: They have battled with the Han Chinese for centuries. The present Chinese government has maintained the policy of trying to turn them into Han Chinese. The Iu Mien have resisted these efforts and still speak their own language as their heart language. Most still practice their ancient religion of ancestor veneration, animism and Taoism. Chinese Christians can go to the Iu Mien and build redemptive relationships with them, they can show the JESUS Film, which is available in Iu Mien. They live in remote mountains that are not easily accessible to Christ's ambassadors. The government stands against efforts to spread the gospel, and the Iu Mien see Christianity as a foreign religion opposed to their traditions and customs. Pray that the Lord would inspire anointed Han Chinese Christian believers to pray for and go to the Hunan Iu Mien. Ask the Lord to raise up a church planting movement among the Iu Mien of China.
- * 2024 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians): #3 Yemen: Pray that God will bring peace and justice to Yemen, and that the cries of His people will not be forgotten. Ask God to protect Yemeni Christians living in places where they could be attacked by Islamic extremists. Pray that God would help the underground church in Yemen flourish, and believers would be able to live as salt and light.
